What is **Osteoarthritis?**

Osteoarthritis is a degenerative joint disease characterised by the breakdown of joint cartilage and underlying bone, typically leading to pain and stiffness, especially in the hip, knee, and thumb joints.



Symptoms of Osteoarthritis



Pain that worsens after activity or toward the end of the day.



Swelling or tenderness in one or more joints.



The formation of bone spurs, which are extra bits of bone that can feel like hard lumps.



Joint stiffness, particularly in the morning or after resting.



A feeling of grating or hearing cracking or popping sounds when the joint moves.





Decreased flexibility or range of motion in the affected joint.

Treatment Options



Hyaluronic Acid Injections

When you have knee osteoarthritis, there may not be enough hyaluronan in your knee joints and the quality may be lower that normal. Viscosupplementation adds hyaluronian to your knee joint, acting as a libricant and shock absorber in the join



Combination of HA and Steroid Injection

A corticosteroid and HA combination treatment is a single intra-articular injection that provides quick pain relief of a corticosteroid, with the long-term pain relief of a viscosupplement. The result is fast and sustained pain relief
